

Quality Assurance Supervisor

Job Summary:

The Quality Assurance Supervisor plans and directs activities concerned with development, application, and maintenance of quality standards for manufacturing processes, materials and products in a Wireless Technology environment. Generates quality system objectives throughout the receiving, production, contract manufacturers and test.

General Responsibilities:

- Assures consistent quality of production by developing and enforcing good manufacturing practice (GMP) in a Wireless Technology environment. Familiar with PCB and PCBA manufacturing and Quality Control.
- Maintains and improves product quality by implementing system compliance, audits; investigating customer complaints and collaborating with other members of management to develop new product and engineering designs, along with manufacturing and training methods.
- Prepares quality documentation and reports by collecting, analyzing and summarizing information and trends including failed processes, stability studies, recalls, corrective actions, and re-validations.
- Specifies quality requirements of raw materials with suppliers.
- Ensures that manufacturing processes comply with standards at both national and international level
- Works with operating staff to establish procedures, standards, and systems
- Determines training needs
- Records, analyzes and distributes statistical information

- Minimum Education: Bachelor's degree in an engineering discipline. Degree in Electrical or Mechanical engineering is preferred.
- Minimum Experience: 5 Years
- Minimum Field of Expertise: Quality Assurance within Wireless technology, PCB and PCBA manufacturing.
